- Improve the teaching of spelling, reading and comprehension for all students, our goal being 90% of students attaining or exceeding regional benchmarks.
- Increase staff capability, through focused coaching, data literacies and professional development to improve student performance in spelling, reading and writing.

Our initiatives include

- Develop effective and efficient school practices and programs to ensure school-wide consistency in the teaching of spelling, reading and comprehension.
- Increase teacher expertise and knowledge of reading comprehension strategies enabling a sharper and more effective delivery of practice across the school.
- Development of a learning community supported through peer mentoring, quality coaching and feedback opportunities, collective planning days aimed at identifying all curriculum literacies in the English Guide To Making Judgments (GTMJ) and peer moderation of student assessment.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Providing small group reading lessons for targeted students.	\$5 000
• Investing in reading materials to engage readers into wanting to read beyond the lessons and class.	\$16 906
• Providing TRS and Professional Development (PD) to develop our knowledgeable other in order to increase staff capacity in spelling, reading and comprehension strategies.	\$10 000
