TARGETS

At 12 months (end of Term 4)

- 90% of students to receive B or higher in English, Maths and Science in 2023.
- 90% of students achieving at year level clusters and 50% achieving above year level clusters on the Literacy Continuum.
- 90% students achieving growth in Relative Gain measure (2024)
- 50 % of students achieving U2B in NAPLAN (2024)
- Review 2022 LOA on data wall to set goals and support for LOA in 2023
